

## FAMILY FUN NIGHT 9-13

This is YOUR night to have fun as a family, so have fun with the below ideas in any order or come up with your own!

### LET'S TALK!

Talking around the table is a great way to connect as a family. Over dinner or dessert ask this question to get the conversation started: Let's talk about friendship! Friendship is using your words and actions to show others you care. How can you show your friends they're important?

Parent Tip: Encourage (but don't force) everyone to share their ideas. Lead the way by having fun with the questions yourself.

### LET'S WATCH!

Watch The Family Fun Night video as a family. [frontrange.org/parentconnect/](http://frontrange.org/parentconnect/) Make it feel like a special event by providing popcorn or other favorite snack. Lead the fun by laughing out loud.

Parent Tip: Leave your phone somewhere else and give your family the gift of undivided attention.

## LET'S GROW!

After the video ask your kids: what was your favorite part? Share yours and what you liked about it.

Say This: We can look for ways to show love to your friends.

Ask This: Q&A FOR KIDS: Who is your best friend? Why do you think you're such good friends?

Q&A FOR PARENTS: Who was your best friend when you were little? How did you meet them? Are you still friends?

Today's Key Question: How can you show your friends they're important?

Today's Bottom Line: Friends love one another.

Basic Truth: I should treat others the way I want to be treated.

## LET'S PLAY!

It's a great conversation starter to talk about how things sometimes look different than they really are. Have each family member use their phone (you may need to loan your phone to a younger member and set it to the camera setting). Take turns going into another room and take an extreme close up of an object. Ask everyone else to guess what it is.

Ideas: extreme close up of a rug or carpet, a picture, or the texture on a pillow.

Parent Tip: For younger family members, have them pair with an older sibling or parent.
